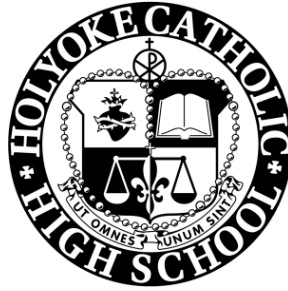


What is Parent Partnership and How Can I Help?
